Topic focus:

Key Vocabulary

Era	A long and distinct period of history e.g. Palaeolithic Era (Early Stone Age). Mesolithic Era (Middle Stone Age) and the Neolithic Era (New Stone Age).
Prehistory	The period before written records. Before people could read or write.
Chronology	The arrangement of dates or events in the order in which they occurred
Cave Paintings	Paintings from the stone age found in caves.
Spear, Borer, Throwing Stones and Hammer Stone	Stone Age weapons and tools.
Stonehenge	A famous prehistoric monument.
Skara Brae	The best preserved stone age village located in the Orkney Isles.
Artefact	An object made by a human being, typically one of cultural or historical interest

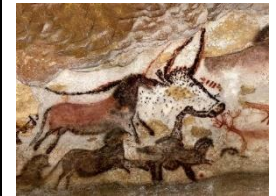
