<u>Key Vocabulary</u>	
Sculpture	An art form in which hard or plastic materials are worked into 3D art objects.
Texture	The effect of the different layers of sound in a piece of music, and the relationship between them.
Solid	A solid can hold its shape (for example, water in solid form is ice).
Liquid	A liquid like water forms a pool: it flows or runs but it can't be stretched or squeezed
Gas	A gas can flow, expand and be squeezed; if it is in an unsealed container it escapes (water in gas form is steam).
Evaporate	To turn from liquid into gas.
Condense	To turn from gas into liquid.
