VISIT TO WINCHESTER SCIENCE MUSEUM – TUESDAY 8TH OCTOBER 2024

Our science this term is about space. In order to bring their learning alive, we are hoping to take the children out for the day to visit Winchester Science Centre and Planetarium on Tuesday 8th October 2024. This will include a session in the planetarium where they will be immersed in the wonders of the solar system; a space workshop about light, which embeds their learning from the Autumn term, and the chance to explore the other exhibits on offer.

In order to cover the cost of this visit we will be seeking payments of £17.70 per child. *If insufficient funds are forthcoming the trip will be cancelled.* Please pay for this online via SCOPAY under the trips and events section. It is also very important that you tick the consent box too or your child will not be able to go on the trip. The deadline for paying for this is Tuesday 1st October 2024. If you are having financial difficulties, please contact the school office for advice. Pupils are required to wear their full school uniform on this day but may wear trainers as they will be on their feet for most of the day.

We will be leaving the school at 9.00 a.m. and returning before the end of the school day. The children will need to bring a packed lunch (please remember, no glass or fizzy drinks) and **no products with nuts of any kind**. Ideally sent in a disposable bag that can be thrown away
